## Becoming an Ordering Physician

---

Only qualifying physicians may order low-THC and medical cannabis for patients.

### **Qualifying physicians must:**

- i. Have an active, unrestricted license under Chapters 458 or 459, Florida Statutes.
  - ii. Complete an 8 hours course and examination provided by the Florida Medical Association and Florida Osteopathic Medical Association.
  - iii. Treat a patient for at least 3 months before patient registration for the Florida registry.
  - iv. Obtain voluntary, written informed consent from the patient/legal representative.
  - v. Maintain a patient treatment plan for each patient and submit the plan quarterly to the University Of Florida School Of Pharmacy.
  - vi. Order no more than a 45-day supply for patients.
- Medical Doctors employed by a Dispensing Organization may not order cannabis for patients.
